[Eligibility Requirements]

- · Good understanding of lectures taught in English
- Excellent academic performance
- · Japanese language proficiency requirements: NONE

[Preferable Candidates]

- · Students who have never been to Japan
- · Students who have never studied Japanese language
- · Students whose major is not Japanese or Japanese studies
- · Undergraduate students
- Preference will be given to students from the local country, but international students studying at the university may also apply.

[Tuition Fees]

No program tuition fees are required.

[Personal Expenses]
