

#### **Awareness**

#### **Principles**

- 1. **Responsibilty:** We take responsibility for how we interact with each other at events and within our structures.
- 2. **Respect:** We treat each other with respect and accept different identities. This includes using preferred names, pronouns and forms of address and not questioning identities.
- 3. **Non-violence:** Physical and psychological violence whether threatened or perpetrated has no place here.
- 4. **Solidarity:** We look out for each other and ensure that there is no room for discrimination. We help or seek help and respect when help is refused.
- 5. **Consent:** Boundaries are individual. We act according to the principle of 'only yes means yes'. We do not pressure or persuade anyone.
- 6. **Communication:** Language can also hurt and discriminate. We therefore use discrimination-sensitive language. We are also sensitive to oversharing, as excessive sharing of private/intimate information can put others in uncomfortable situations.
- 7. **Listening:** We listen to each other and take each other seriously. Only the person affected can determine whether a boundary has been violated.
- 8. **Alcohol consumption:** There is an attractive selection of non-alcoholic beverages at every event. No one is pressured or coerced into consuming alcohol. Alcohol is not served to minors (under 16, hard alcohol under 18).

#### **Awareness Team**

- Our Awareness Team (AT) is available if you feel uncomfortable whether during Freshers' Week, students' board events or in any other context related to your studies. The AT also manages the relaxation room and the awareness kit at events.
